Race Fees: \$20

- The fee includes an amount to cover biathlon costs.
- Coaches and volunteers on skis are given complimentary passes
- OISRAN/Sarah Swaney will pay Hoodoo for all the passes and pick up the passes prior to race. Sarah will invoice all teams for race fees.
- All persons on skis must have a trail pass. It is your release of liability.

Race Format: 4.5K Skate Biathlon, interval start (11:00 am) 1.6K Short Course Skate Biathlon, interval start (~11:45 am)

High school racers' Bibs:

- The bibs for Southern League skiers that are pre-assigned for the whole season and will be distributed at this event. Coaches, please keep all of your skiers' bibs.
- Southern League skiers who are participating in the Short Course will wear red tie-on bibs instead of their preassigned stretchy bibs. These bibs must be returned after the Biathlon.
- Racers from other leagues (NL and MHL) pick up your bibs at check-in and return bibs after the Biathlon. If your skier is doing the Short Course, their bib will be a red tie-on bib.

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Food will be provided: Hot Chocolate, Soup, bagels, and fruit.

Summary of Start Timing Procedures (Reference OISRAN Race Rule 13.1) Racer starts on the "GO" command, after a verbal countdown and an audible beep from the timing software.

Any early start that is greater than 3 seconds early will be penalized by a 15second time penalty.

The notes of the start supervisor will be used to recalculate any early start that is less than 3 seconds early.

Racers gain no advantage by starting before "GO," and they risk a 15second penalty.

Overtaking another skier in an interval start race (Reference OISRAN Race Rule 10.6.2)

The racer being overtaken in an interval start race must give way on the first demand, whether it is a classic race or a skate race.

PAINTBALL MARKER SAFTEY:

- 1) Treat all PAINTBALL MARKERS as if they were LOADED (No Horseplay)
- 2) Keep your finger off the TRIGGER until you are ready to FIRE.
- 3) Point the PAINTBALL MARKER only at the TARGET that you intend to SHOOT (THE LASER RULE).

4) Be 100% sure of your target (SITUATIONAL AWARENESS).

PAINTBALL MARKER SHOOTING TIPS

- 1. **Control your BREATHING.**
- 2. **RELEASE Paintball Marker SAFETY.**
- 3. Establish SIGHT PICTURE. | | |

RED FRONT SIGHT.

BLACK REAR SIGHTS.

- 4. Focus on FRONT SIGHT, then FRONT SIGHT onto CENTER OF TARGET. O
- 5. **SQUEEZE the trigger.**
- 6. ADJUST sight picture for next shot if necessary.
- 7. Return Paintball Marker back into SAFETY MODE.
